Regarding *ottostaudingeri*, the replacement name proposed by the authors for *Cigaritis maxima* (page 35), Dr. Lamas states: "I believe *uighurica* is the valid name for this species. You're right in rejecting *maxima* Staudinger as a junior secondary homonym of *maximus* Elwes, but Kemal & Koçak effectively replaced it by *uighurica*, even though the latter name was introduced in a relatively unsatisfactory manner. The name *uighurica* is not a *nomen nudum* because K & K gave at least one character (size) separating it from *minima* (see Art. 13.1.1 of the Code). Furthermore, K & K referred to *maxima* Staudinger, which implies that the type-series (and differentiating characters) of *maxima* were included in the diagnosis of *uighurica*, thus making available the latter name. From that type series (the *uighurica* specimens, plus the *maxima* specimens), K & K designated as holotype a male from Malatya, deposited in CESA. Thus, *uighurica* is not a "junior objective synonym" of *maxima* as you state. The name *ottostaudingeri* is a junior objective synonym of *maxima*, but a junior subjective synonym of *uighurica*, and the latter has priority, as the action by K & K was nomenclaturally valid, and complies with all relevant provisions of the Code".
